

## **Prof. Oded Nahlieli**

### ***Endoscopic Surgery and Treatment of the Salivary Glands***

Prof. Oded Nahlieli graduated the Hebrew University Hadassah School of Dental medicine in Jerusalem. He completed his Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery residency in Israel; residency during 1988-1989, in the Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery Department in Massachusetts General Hospital Boston USA.

Prof. Nahlieli is the chairman of the Department of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery at the Barzilai Medical Center Ashkelon, Israel. He is an Associate Professor at the Ben Gurion University of the Negev and Adjunct Associate Professor at the New York University College of Dentistry.

Since 1993 Dr. Nahlieli began developing the practice of Endoscopy of the salivary glands (Sialoendoscopy) and was one of the pioneers in the field. He has extensive experience in salivary gland endoscopy having performed more than 2500 sialoendoscopies.

He developed a series of endoscopes techniques and specific equipments for minimal invasive procedures in dentistry and medicine. He has lectured extensively on his specialty in Europe, Middle East and North America.

Prof. Nahlieli primary responsibilities include treatment and surgery of:

Salivary gland sialadenitis

Salivary glands sialolithiasis

Endoscopic surgery of the salivary glands

Lingual and Inferior alveolar nerve injuries

Prof. Oded Nahlieli has written more than 90 articles 10 chapters one book and obtained 25 patents, published in the international literature. His articles on Sialoendoscopy are considered keystones in the modern management of salivary glands inflammatory disorders.
